"MUNICIPAL REGULATORY ORDINANCE NO. 01-2008

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS TO SECURE A BUSINESS PERMIT/LICENSE REGISTRATION PLATE AND THE SAME SHOULD BE POSTED/DISPLAYED IN THE MOST VISIBLE PLACE OF THE BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT

WHEREAS, R.A.7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 has empowered each local government unit to create its own sources of revenue through the levy of taxes, fees and charges subject to the limitations imposed therein as doing consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid law further authorizes each local government unit to regulate any business, occupation or practice of profession within its territorial jurisdiction through the issuance of permits and licenses for the purpose of promoting the general welfare of its constituents subject to such minimum terms and conditions as formulated through an appropriate ordinance;

WHEREAS, in accordance in Section 447 of the R.A. 7160, the Sangguniang Bayan, as the legislative body of the local government unit shall enact ordinance to regulate activities to utilization of lands, buildings and structures within its jurisdiction;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled, that:

SECTION I. DEFINITION OF TERMS. - For purpose of proper implementation of this Ordinance, the terms hereunder provided shall have the following meaning, to wit:

- a. Business/Mayor/s Permit - shall refer to the legal authority of all person/s (natural or juridical), business establishments, offices institutions and similar others to operate within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality for a given period of time.
- b. Business Permit Registration Plate - as used in this Ordinance shall refer to the Letter Coded registration plates with uniform design showing that a particular business operator is a legitimate and duly registered business operating within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality after compliance with all the requirements under existing rules and regulations.
- c. Validating Stickers - as used in this Ordinance shall mean a legitimate stickers printed by the local government unit showing that the Business Permit Registration Plate of a particular business operator has been duly renewed for the ensuing fiscal year or every so after as required by existing laws and appropriate ordinance.
- d. Actual Cost of Registration Plate - shall refer to the actual expenses incurred by the Municipal Government in the fabrication of the Business Registration Plates. The amount hereunder fixed shall be in addition to the amount computed by the Municipal Treasurer's Office.

SECTION II. FEES/CHARGES. - all persons applying for the issuance of Business/Mayor's Permit shall be required to pay an additional imposition in the amount mentioned - below representing the actual cost incurred by the municipality for the fabrication of the color-coded business registration plates, to wit:

New Business Registration Plate	- P 300.00
Renewal of Sticker	- 30.00

In the event of loss, destruction or defaced of the Business Registration Plate, immediate replacement of the same must be initiated by the grantee subject to payment in the amount charge to every new application.

SECTION III. POSTING/DISPLAYING OF BUSINESS PERMIT REGISTRATION PLATE. - Upon securing such business Permit Registration Plate from Business Licenses and Permit Section, the business operator shall post and display the same in a conspicuous location within his establishment to be readily seen or viewed by the government inspectors in order to facilitate the proper identification of any unauthorized and/or non-registered business establishments

which shall enable the government to properly enforce applicable laws and appropriate ordinances.

SECTION IV. PROHIBITED ACTS - Effective upon approval of this Ordinance, it is hereby declared unauthorized the following acts, to wit:

- a. Failure to secure or renew the Business Registration Plate prior to its business operation.
- b. Failure to place the business plate at the area required.
- c. Unauthorized fabrication of Business Registration Plate.
- d. Alteration or destruction of the Business Registration Plate.
- e. Utilization of Business Registration Plate of another.
- f. Such other acts that the local government may consider unauthorized or invalid.

SECTION V. PENALTY - Any act that is found in violation of the foregoing provisions shall have the corresponding penalty:


- a. First Offense - Warning
- b. Second offense - Fine of P300.00 and or suspension to operate for a period of 15 days
- c. Third Offense - Fine of P500.00 and revocation of Business Permit

The penalty imposed under this section shall not bar the municipality from imposing other penalties provided under existing, rules and regulations.


SECTION VI - REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations or part thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


