**"MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE 02-2008**

WHEREAS, in consideration of the petition of the motorized tricycle operators and drivers for a fare rate adjustment due to the unprecedented increase of the cost of gasoline and oil products and tricycle spare parts;

WHEREAS, the committee sees the legitimacy of the request for fare increase considering that every oil price hike will eventually lead to increase in the prices of commodities including the cost of vehicle maintenance;

WHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan Ng Buug, Zamboanga Sibugay:

Section 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall be known and acted as "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 07-2005 REGULATING THE FARE OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BUUG, ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY.

Section 2. General Provisions. To adopt the herein rules and regulations for the implementation of the adjusted fare rate for the motorized tricycles-for-hire, to wit:

- a. All identifications and schedule of fare rates issued to tricycle drivers/operators shall at all times be conspicuously displayed at the tricycle for the information of the riding public;
- b. The tricycle drivers/operators shall not refuse to convey passengers and/or cargoes nor cause to cutting trips without justifiable reason/s;
- c. All tricycle drivers/operators are required to observe personal cleanliness and sanitation, and the wearing of long pants and shoes while driving; and to provide trash receptacle are required in the Municipal Ordinance No.01-2005;

- d. Mufflers and silencers should not be removed from the motor engines so as to preclude noise pollution;
- e. Any driver/operator of motorized tricycle is hereby authorized only to a maximum capacity of five (5) passengers for his/her units;
- f. The one (1.00) Peso fare discount herein accorded to students, and P1.60 for Senior Citizens and differently abled persons, as provided herein shall be respected by the tricycle drivers/operators and be applied for all trips within the municipality regardless of their points of origin and/or destination;
- g. All tricycle driver/operator should always observed road courtesy, traffic rules and regulations and is required to provide appropriate protection of the passenger/s especially against the rain;
- h. Any driver/operator should disallow children and/or ladies wearing skirts from taking the driver's backseat;
- i. The posting of unwholesome pictures, slogan and/or commercial advertisement in any part of the tricycle shall not be tolerated, instead, the printing by biblical passages and/or quotations that shall positively promote and uplift the municipalities image is greatly encouraged;
- j. The speed limit of thirty (30) kilometers per hour, as contemplated in Municipal Ordinance No. G-02-92, must be properly and religiously adhered to at all times, and other traffic laws, rules and regulations, the observance of which must be strictly monitored by the traffic enforces assigned for the purpose of managing vehicular traffic situations;

Section 3 - Matrix. - A matrix of the lawful fares and freight shall be placed on the lower hand corner of the windshield, failure to provide such matrix shall authorized the apprehending officer to take the motorized tricycle to the nearest police station and release the same only upon compliance thereof and payment of the administrative fine of P50.00;


Section 4- Deadline of Issuance. - Issuance of matrix shall only be up to July 31,2008;


Section 5- Effectivity. This shall take effect upon its approval.
