"MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 01-2007"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the municipality of Buug, Province of Zamboanga Sibugay, in session assembled:

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known and thereafter referred to as an Ordinance amending the Municipal Ordinance No. 02-2006 known as "Buug Ecological Solid Waste Management Ordinance" which shall now read in whole.

Section 53 – Time of Payment; Penalties for Delinquency

- a. SWM Fees shall be collected on monthly and quarterly basis on or before 20th of the month and on or before the 20th of the first month of a quarter.
- b. Failure to pay the fees within the time required shall subject the taxpayer to a surcharge of 25%. Such surcharge to be paid at the same time.

Section 54 – Collection and Allocation of Proceeds of SWM Fees

1. All public market stalls being owned by the Local Government Unit, the Municipal Treasurer shall collect the necessary fees for garbage collection.
2. The Municipal Treasurer shall deputize the Barangay Treasurer subject to existing laws & regulations to collect the SWM Fees payable by household only in their respective jurisdictions.
3. The proceeds of the SWM Fees collected by the Barangay Treasurers be apportioned as follows:
 - a. 60% shall accrue to the General Fund of the municipality and shall be liquidated monthly.
 - b. 40% shall accrue to the Barangay when tax is collected
4. 100% of the proceeds of the SWM Fees actually collected by the Municipal Treasurer shall accrue directly to the General Fund of the municipality.

Section 55 – Place of Payment- The ESWM Fees shall be paid to the Office of the Municipal Treasurer or to the deputized Barangay Treasurer.

Section 61. Fines and Penalties

a) Any person who violates Section 60 as well as other provisions of this ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

1. First Offense –Php 100.00
2. Second Offense Php250.00
3. Third Offense - Php500.00

Section 69. Incentives/Rewards - The following incentives/rewards shall be given to the following:


b. Auxiliary Enforcers and Deputized Volunteers

- For every apprehension, a cash award of Fifty Percent (50%) of the penalty actually paid shall be given to the auxiliary enforcer or deputized volunteer immediately upon approval of the corresponding voucher that shall be made for the disbursement of said award.


Section 2. Effectivity. – This shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

"RESOLUTION NO. 01-2007

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 01-2005 known as the "Buug Ecological Solid Waste Management Ordinance of 2004" was amended by the Sangguniang Bayan of this municipality on March 6, 2006 under Municipal Ordinance No. 02-2006;

WHEREAS, there are some provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 02-2006 that need to be re-amended to suit with the present situation and in order to implement the said Ordinance more effectively;

NOW, THEREFORE, finding this necessary and on unanimous motion by the members present, duly seconded, it was;

RESOLVED to request the Sangguniang Bayan of this municipality to amend the following provisions of Municipal Ordinance No. 02-2006, to wit:

Section 53. Payment - The monthly fees listed above may be paid on a monthly, quarterly, semi-annual or annual basis.

Amendment:

Section 53 - Time of Payment; Penalties for Delinquency

- a. *SWM Fees shall be collected on monthly and quarterly basis on or before 20th Of the month and on or before the 20th of the first month of a quarter.*
- b. *Failure to pay the fees within the time required shall subject the taxpayer to a surcharge of 25%. Such surcharge to be paid at the same time.*

Section 54. Barangay Share in the Fees Collected For collections made by barangays, the amount collected shall be shared as follows:

- a. 60% shall be remitted to the Municipal Treasurer's Office
- b. 40% shall be retained by the barangay treasurer and shall form part of the barangay funds.

Amendment:

Section 54 - Collection and Allocation of Proceeds of SWM Fees

1. *All public market stalls being owned by the Local Government Unit, the Municipal Treasurer shall collect the necessary fees for garbage collection.*
2. *The Municipal Treasurer shall deputize the Barangay Treasurer subject to existing laws & regulations to collect the SWM Fees payable by household only in their respective jurisdictions.*
3. *The proceeds of the SWM Fees collected by the Barangay Treasurers be apportioned as follows:*
 - a. *60% shall accrue to the General Fund of the municipality and shall be liquidated monthly.*
 - b. *40% shall accrue to the Barangay when tax is collected*
4. *100% of the proceeds of the SWM Fees actually collected by the Municipal Treasurer shall accrue directly to the General Fund of the municipality.*

Section 55. Manner of Payment/ Collection - The fees imposed herein shall be paid/collected as follows:

- a) For households - Fees will be collected by the respective barangay treasurers.
- b) For institutions, industrial and commercial establishments - The collection of fees shall be integrated into the payment of annual business permit fees, in annual or quarterly basis and shall be collected by the barangay treasurer.

Amendment:

Section 55 - Place of Payment- The ESWM Fees shall be paid to the Office of the Municipal Treasurer or to the deputized Barangay Treasurer.

Section 61. Fines and Penalties

a) Any person who violates Section 60 as well as other provisions of this ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

1. First Offense -Php 100.00 or 1 hour community service (sweeping/cleaning the bus terminal and other public areas, cleaning the public toilet)
2. Second Offense Php250.00 or 2 hours community service (sweeping/cleaning the bus terminal and other public areas, cleaning the public toilet)
3. Third Offense - Php500.00 of half-day community service (sweeping/cleaning the bus terminal and other public areas, cleaning the public toilet)

Amendment:

Section 61. Fines and Penalties

a) Any person who violates Section 60 as well as other provisions of this ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

- 1. First Offense -Php 100.00*
- 2. Second Offense Php250.00*
- 3. Third Offense - Php500.00*

Section 69. Incentives/Rewards - The following incentives/rewards shall be given to the following:

- b. Auxiliary Enforcers and Deputized Volunteers

- For every apprehension, a cash award of Five Percent (5%) of the penalty actually paid but not exceeding Php100.00 shall be paid to the auxiliary enforcer or deputized volunteer on a monthly basis.

Amendment:

Section 69. Incentives/Rewards - The following incentives/rewards shall be given to the following:


b. Auxiliary Enforcers and Deputized Volunteers

- *For every apprehension, a cash award of Fifty Percent (50%) of the penalty actually paid shall be given to the auxiliary enforcer or deputized volunteer immediately upon approval of the corresponding voucher that shall be made for the disbursement of said award.*


