MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 31-2024

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF WATER REFILLING STATIONS AND THE BUSINESS OF SELLING WATER IN THE MUNICIPALITY, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATORS THEREOF

SECTION 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known and cited as the Water Refilling Stations Regulatory Ordinance of Buug, Zamboanga Sibugay;

SECTION 2. Definition of Terms. In the implementation of this Ordinance, the following terms and phrases shall mean:

- 2.1 **Water Refilling Station:** shall mean establishments engaged in the collection, purification, distribution, and sale of drinking water;
- 2.2 **D.O.H.:** shall refer to the Department of Health;
- 2.3 **Coliform:** shall refer to bacteria or impurities which make the water unsafe for human consumption.
- 2.4 **Approved Source:** refers to the source of water either spring, drilled well, public or community water system or any other source that has been inspected and the water has been sampled, examined, analyzed and found safe and sanitary, with or without treatment;

SECTION 3. Implementing Rules and Regulations. In addition to the requirements provided for in the Revenue Code in securing Business Permits, and for purposes of this ordinance, the following rules and regulations are hereby prescribed to owners and operators of Water Refilling Stations:

- 3.1 Employees working inside the refilling area shall be required to wear hair nets, gloves, mask and uniforms and must undergo food handler's trainings;
- 3.2 Containers used shall be sealed for sanitation purposes;
- 3.3 Subject samples of their products to Physical and Chemical Examinations at least twice (2x) a year;
- 3.4 Subject samples of their products to Coliform examination with a DOH accredited testing center monthly and submit its result to the Sanitary Inspector not later than the end of the month, and,
- 3.5 Secure the necessary occupational and health certificates for all employees;

SECTION 4. Duties of Sanitary Inspectors. Sanitary Inspectors who exercise jurisdiction over the water refilling stations shall have the following duties:

- 4.1 Conduct monthly sanitary inspection in all water refilling stations;
- 4.2 Collect samples from water refilling stations for examinations to DOH-accredited institutions;
- 4.3 Require on time submission of coliform and bacteriological examination results from owners and operators and keep a record of the same for further assessment, and
- 4.4 Submit to the Mayor's office and to the Committee on Health of the Sangguniang Bayan monthly inspection reports together with testing results

SECTION 5. Approval of Source. No clearance of source shall be issued unless an ocular inspection has been conducted by the Local Health Officer;

SECTION 6. Dealers or Distributors from Outside the Municipality. All water refilling stations outside the Municipality shall not be allowed to conduct and operate their business through dealership, distribution or retail within the Municipality;

SECTION 7. Penal Provisions. The following penalties shall be imposed to violators of this Ordinance:

7.1 For violations of sub-paragraph 1 & 2 of Section 3: (3.1 and 3.2)

First Offense – a fine of three hundred pesos (P500.00);
Second Offense – a fine of five hundred pesos (P700.00);
Third Offense – a fine of one thousand pesos (P1,000.00);

7.2 For violations of sub-paragraph 3, and 5 of Section 3, and Section 6 hereof:
(3.3, 3.4, 3.5)

First Offense – a fine of one thousand pesos (P1,500.00);
Second offense – a fine of two thousand pesos (P2,000.00)
Third Offense – a fine of two thousand five hundred pesos (2,500.00) and
revocation of the business permit and closure of the establishment;

SECTION 8. Separability Clause. In any event that any provision of this Ordinance is found and declared null and void in accordance with law, all other provisions of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect;

SECTION 9. Repealing Clause. All other ordinances, rules or regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, modified, and amended accordingly

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. - This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
